
Safecare training guide

1. “The Training Guide for Threat Response”

A document which describes the theoretical and practical training addressed to the targeted audience. The document identifies the learning approach, goals and objectives of the training, the targeted audience, the content and modules of the course, the evaluation methodology.

2. Online Course

The multimedia training guide was developed on the dedicated section on CSI e-learning platform, based on LCMS Moodle, called **Smart3L** (www.smart3L.it).
